Members made the following comments:

2019/21002/FUL, Proposed flood water storage scheme at Aireville Park – No objection. However, Members wonder if in the future the installation of turbines for generating electricity could be included within similar applications. The Committee suggest that the planning authority should speak to the Environment Agency with regard to this.

2019/21140/REM, Demolition of existing workshops & construction of 7 houses at Pendle Street Garage – No objection

2019/21108/REM, Approval of partial layout (road infrastructure) at Land North of A629 & West of Carleton Road – No objection. Those present at the meeting ask the planning authority what was the developer's response to the Town Council's comments about the siting of the recreation area.

SNN/00856 Former St Monica's Convent, Skipton – Members would prefer that wording is used to reflect the former usage e.g. St Monica's Court

SNN/00524 Land to the south of Burnside Crescent, Skipton – Members object to the name Spencer Crescent as it could cause confusion due to 'Spencer' being used in other parts of town but are happy with the other names. The Committee suggested that Ellerwood Close could be used instead.
