1. To accept representations from the Public between 6.30 pm and 6.45 pm.

2. To accept apologies for absence.

Apologies were accepted from Councillors Emmerson, Harbron, Rankine and Dow.

3. To record declarations of pecuniary and non-pecuniary interests of items on the Agenda.

Councillor Kerr declared a non-pecuniary interest with regard to agenda item 11 as his partner works for Craven District Council.

4. To consider the recommendations of the Chief Officer relating to requests for dispensations to Members on items requiring a declaration of pecuniary and non-pecuniary interests.

5. To accept the minutes from the previous meeting held on 13 October 2016.

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6. To report and receive information arising from the minutes of items not on the agenda from members and the Chief Officer.

7. To consider matters relating to the Town Council's land to the west of the junction of Carleton New Road and Carleton Road in terms of the District Council's Strategic Housing Land Availability Assessment (SHLAA) Annual Review 2017.

The Committee held no objection to the Council's land being included in the SHLAA review. However, it was **RESOLVED** that this matter should be deferred for further discussion by the Finance and Policy Committee in terms of the possible sale of this land together with the ransom strip on the former Burnside Allotments.

8. To discuss a proposal to position a mini-roundabout at the junction of Carleton Road, Carleton New Road and Brooklands Terrace.

Members were unsure of the reasoning behind this proposal and **RESOLVED** to inform North Yorkshire County Council they were under the impression that the Wyvern Park development included a slip road to direct larger vehicles straight on to the by-pass.

9. To note issues raised by a resident regarding the roundabout adjacent to HML and the Auction Mart on Gargrave Road.

It was **RESOLVED** to forward the complainant's correspondence on to North Yorkshire County Council Highways for their attention whilst explaining that the roundabout is actually within the parish of Stirton.

10. To consider a request to provide disabled parking spaces on Clitheroe Street and Broughton Road, Skipton.

No objection provided the spaces are removed when the residents needing them have moved on.

11. To consider proposals to make changes to the 'Craven District Council (Off Street Parking Places) and (Consolidation) Order 2015.
