Members made the following observations:

The Committee suggest that prior to this development being approved by the Planning Authority a full survey is undertaken to prove that there is sufficient capacity for rain water run-off from higher up Greatwood Estate, including all other planned developments, heading downhill towards and under the railway line to prove there is no potential for flooding until the water reaches the official floodplain.

Should this proposal be approved the developer must ensure that the play area is maintained to an acceptable standard with costs covered for the foreseeable future.

Members note that the 40% affordable housing quota required for new builds is not met with regard to this development.
